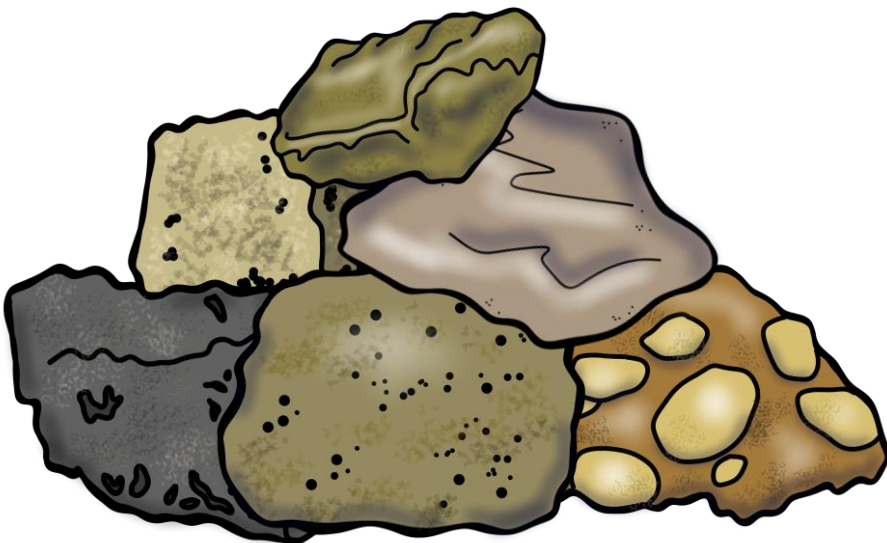


GAME: Build an Altar (Younger and Older Children)



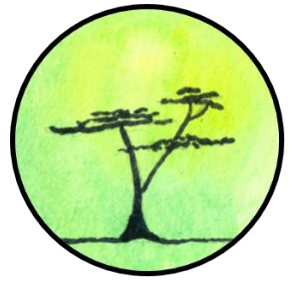
Many times in the Old Testament we see people building an altar to worship God or to remember something important that happened. Try this activity to help the students understand altars and relate to the character in the story

Ask the students to go out and gather rocks. Say: We are going to build an altar just like in the Old Testament. As you are choosing your rock, think of one thing that you would like to trust God with. We will come together and put the rocks in a pile. As you place your rock in the pile say what you like about God.



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
