

If God Speaks Why Can't I hear Him?

One student will play God, hiding so that he can't be seen. "God" should be given a microphone so that the audience can hear what he's saying while not being able to see him. Every time a student walks in God calls their name, but they are too occupied to listen.

Student 1: [Addresses audience.] **You know what I can't understand is, if God speaks, why can't I hear Him?** [exits.]

Student 2: [Enters listening to loud music on headphones. Dancing and singing along.]

God: Hello. [calls name of student several times.]

Student 3: [Enters very busy. Studying for test while cleaning the house, taking care of younger brothers and sisters – has no time to stop and listen. Does not hear God.]

God: [calls name of student several times]

Student 4: [Enters talking loudly to friends on the phone.] **Hey! You know what I heard as well! That Mary is not going to school anymore! Can you believe it? I mean, what does she think she's doing? Do you think she could be pregnant? I don't know! It sound suspicious to me...**[Does not hear God and exits.]

God: [calls name of student several times.]

[Quickly set up a church scene. While pastor preaches, students 5 & 6 begin talking to each other in the back and disrupting church. Students do not hear God calling.]

God: [calls names of students several times.]

Student 7: [occupied with taking selfies, posting to facebook on phone, texting with friends, etc. Does not hear God and exits.]

God: [calls name of student several times.]
