

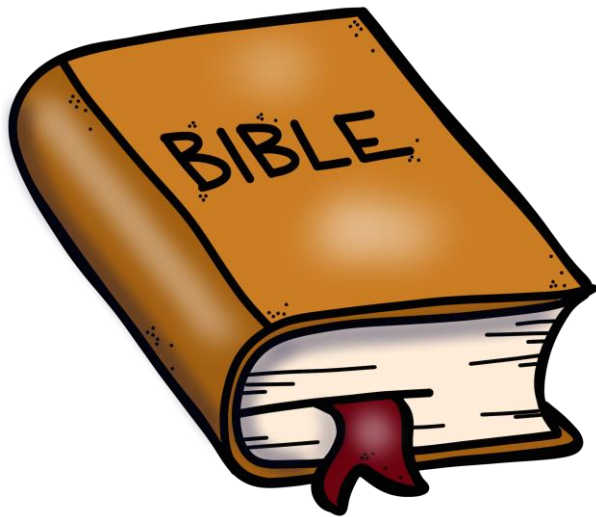
# Memory VERSE Activity

## Instructions:

Print. Cut apart on the dotted lines. Mix up the order of the phrases and tape one phrase each to the back of a student. Do not tell the students what is written on their backs. Then, have the students unscramble themselves and put the words in the correct order so that the class can read it.



## MEMORY VERSE:



Numbers 23:19

“God is not human, that he should lie, not a human being, that he should change his mind. Does he speak and then not act? Does he promise and not fulfill?”

Review memory verse.

Cut apart on the dotted line and in a mixed order tape each piece to the back of several different students. Do not tell them what you are putting on their backs. Only tell them that it is a part of the memory verse. Next, tell the students that they must arrange themselves in the correct order according to the memory verse so that the class can read it. Do not allow the class to help them, they must figure out how to do this on their own by helping each other.

Once the students have successfully arranged themselves, have the class read the verse correctly from the backs of the students in the correct order. Then have one student sit down. There should be a space where that student was standing. Have the class recite the verse again having to remember what was in the now black space. Next have a second student sit down and so on. Continue until the class has memorized the entire verse.

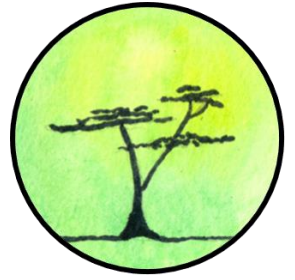
