

## Snake Activity

Set up the room like a giant obstacle course, make sure there is no straight line across the room -- no need to add extra things, the chairs and any tables should be enough.

Have the small groups choose one leader and one advisor. The rest of the team will get in a single file line behind the leader, each person with their hands on the shoulders of the person in front of them. The advisor stands off to the side. Everyone except the advisor will have their eyes closed. The advisor can only whisper to the leader and can't touch anyone.

The advisor's job is to whisper in the leader's ear to help them lead the rest of the team through the room without anyone touching anything. There should be at least 2 "spotters" from the adult leaders to help ensure safety.

Note: This can be used as a simple game for people to play or it can be used as an activity to introduce a topic like; the blind leading the blind, how to be a good leader, the importance of following God's instructions for us, etc. If you are using it as an introduction to your topic, make sure you

explain to the students how the activity relates to the idea that you are going to talk about.
