Scene: Youth camp and students are going to play a game. Several students can play along as long as everyone has a partner.

Instructor: **Ok, everyone grab a partner. Now, we are going to play a game about being close to each other. Ready. I want all partners to become attached at the head. As I call out the instructions I want you to do the activity without separating heads, OK?**

- **Touch your toes**
- **Walk in a circle**
- **Sit down**
- **Each of you take off one shoe**
- **Shake hands with members of another pair**
- **Nod your head yes**
- **Stand back to back**
- **Pretend to wash your face**
- **Hop on one foot**

Allow partners to separate and sit down.

Instructor: **What do you think it might be like to be a Siamese twin joined at the head?**

(Students Respond)
