

## GAME: Trust Circle (Older Children)

Items needed: Blindfold

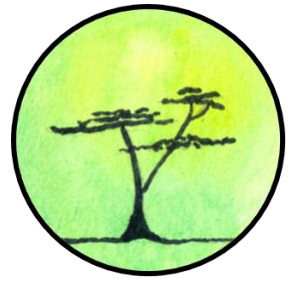
Choose 4 – 5 kids to make a tight circle. Choose one kid to stand in the middle of the circle blindfolded. The kid in the middle should cross their arms over their chest. Tell the other kids that it is their job to keep the kid in the middle standing up. Tell the kid in the middle to be very straight and start to lean or fall in one direction. The kids on the outside of the circle should make sure that the one in the middle does not fall and can gently push him/her in another direction.



Connect the game with how Abram followed wherever God led him in whatever way he led him. Abram did not know where he was going nor could he see what the future held, but he followed. In order to follow God, we have to trust him. We have to trust that he will provide for us and catch us if we fall. In life we have a chance to be a leader.
